◆ H O R N & B O N E ◆

Water buffalo horn and bone jewelry is made in SE Asia in mm sizes (approximate gauge or inch measurements are listed). Please note that **horn is black** (or sometimes a lighter creamy tan or a translucent rootbeer brown color), and **bone is white**. Current availability and exact pricing is reflected in our latest catalog, on page 3. These updates can be downloaded from our website or sent through the mail. International customers will be asked to sign a release form stating that it is legal to import these items into their country, without any special permits.

The sample prices below are *per pair* (except septums and labrets).

•Horn or bone: septum tusks, spikes, or pinchers (~21ga-3/4") are \$4-15/each; labrets (~16ga-5/8") are \$5-14/each; or \$12-22/each in fossil mammoth ivory. Also: septum tusks with inlaid dots, and horn labrets with opal inlays.

Horn saddles: plugs with two flares

•Bone dust inlays, or engraved and painted: 10ga-6ga-\$10 • 4ga-\$11 2ga-\$12 • 0ga-\$13 • 00ga-\$14 • 7/16"-\$15 • 1/2"-\$16 • 5/8"-\$20 • 3/4"-\$28 7/8"-\$32 • 1"-\$36 • 1-1/8"-\$38 • 1-1/4"-\$40 • 1-3/8"-\$45 • 1-1/2"-\$50 • 1-5/8"-\$55.

•Plain hollow, or hollow with cut out stars on the front faces: 4ga (plain only) & 2ga, 0ga, 00ga-\$10-\$12 • 7/16"-\$13 • 1/2"-\$15 • 9/16"-\$16 • 5/8"-\$18 3/4"-\$20 • 7/8"-\$22 • 1"-\$26 • 1-1/8" to 1-1/4"-\$30 • 1-3/8"-\$35 • 1-1/2"-\$40/pr.

•Hollow with cut out spirals or triskels: 0ga through 1-3/4" • \$13 to \$55/pair.

•Hollow with Borneo flares, Marquesas designs, or silver Berber dots: 00ga to 2".

•Hollow & solid bone (+large moose antler): 6ga-\$12 • 0ga-\$16 • 1/2"-\$24 +

•Fossilized mammoth ivory: between 0ga & 00ga • <1/2" • 5/8"-\$30 discounted.

•Silver cap overlays: 0ga-\$18 • 00ga-\$20 • 7/16"-\$23 • 5/8"-\$30 • 3/4"-\$32 7/8"-\$35 • 1"-\$42 • 1-1/8"-\$45 • 1-1/4"-\$50 • 1-3/8"-\$60 • 1-5/8"-\$70/pair.

•Solid (3ga+) or hollow (5/8+) opal inlays & other unique inlays up to 2"

Horn shapes

•Upside down U's: 8ga, 6ga, 4ga-\$10/pair • 2ga, 0ga, 00ga-\$12/pair.

•Omega's: 8ga, 6ga, 4ga-\$12 • 2ga-\$13 • 0ga-\$14 • 00ga-\$15/pair.

•CBR's: 14,13,12,11,10,9,8,7,6ga-\$12 • 4ga-\$13 • 2ga-\$14 • 0ga-\$15 • 00ga-\$16.

•Square CBR's & Yoni's: 8-4ga-\$12 • 2ga-\$13 • 0ga-\$14 • 00ga-\$15/pair.

•Java style (ring shape with upturned ends): 8ga-4ga-\$15 • 2-0ga-\$17 • 00ga-\$20.

•Compact or wicked spirals: 8-6ga-\$12 • 4ga-\$15 • 2ga-\$16 • 0ga-\$18 • 00ga-\$18 7/16"-\$20 • 1/2"-\$22 • 9/16"-\$25 • 5/8"-\$28/pair • Medium spirals: 8ga-\$15/pair.

•Homegirl spirals: 8-6ga-\$18 • 4ga-\$20 • 0ga-\$22 • 00ga-\$24 • 1/2"-\$28 • 5/8"-\$34.

•Tapered claws with balls (also in BONE); bone dust inlay is extra in 00ga+; 8ga-4ga-\$12 • 2ga-\$15 • 0ga-00ga-\$16 • 7/16"-\$18 • 1/2"-\$21 • 5/8"-\$24/pair.

Also: super tiny spirals (15ga-10ga-\$12), stretched spirals, bamboo rhizome hoops, nail head hoops (6ga to 0ga), dragon or monster claws, and BONE CBR's and spirals!

◆ Q U I L L S & O T H E R B O N E ◆

•Porcupine quills (for septums, tapers, and hairsticks): 5 for \$1 American quills (tiny to =16ga; =2" long); \$2 larger African quills (13ga-1ga; 3"-12" long).

•Warthog and boar's tusks, various penis bones (baculum), snake ribs, bone talons, tapers, and teeth are all available-please see the website.

•Fossilized mammoth or walrus ivory, oosik, antler, and other bone plugs and labrets are more rare, and thus only occasionally in stock.

•Nautilus, dentalium, and other shells, sea urchin UFOs, stingray spines, framed butterflies, skulls, goat & cow horns, & other natural history items.

◆ B A M B O O ◆

Bamboo is a type of grass that is naturally hollow, lightweight, and cylinder shaped. It normally ranges from light yellow to light green to tan brown in color. The edges of the plugs are slightly rounded (beveled/chamfered) and come pre-oiled with jojoba oil.

Specify diameter (approximate, due to the slightly oval shape of bamboo; the current minimum is 11ga; maximum is =2-1/2"... and length. 1/2" is the average length. Specify with or without o-rings. Allow an average of 2-3 weeks for custom bamboo orders to be made.

We often have some pre-made bamboo plugs in stock, just ask!

Add half the pair price: one side solid, burnt ends, or lengths ≥1".  
Black bamboo is occasionally available for \$2 extra/pair.

◆ A M B E R ◆

•Baltic amber is normally translucent orange honey colored, either with "sun spangle" (lily pad) shaped inclusions or clear; it has gone through the traditional clarification and heat-treating processes.

•Mexican amber tends to be clear yellow-orange, often with dark moss-like inclusions, and is not clarified nor heat-treated. We often have Aztec style labrets & regular or 3-D engraved plugs.

•Please note that supply is limited and hard to acquire and we often sell out of many (especially large) sizes.

•The best way to get 3/4" and larger sizes is to ask to be on our waiting list.

•Ask about old Burmese amber plugs & polished amber specimens & copal pieces ("young amber") with bugs.

•We do not have amber plugs with insects nor green amber.
