

## ♦ H A R D W O O D ♦

Wood plugs are made out of high quality hardwood. These may work best in "dry" areas of the body, especially the ears. Remember, this is a natural, organic product, and there is a chance that some individuals will be more sensitive than others to the materials; some may even develop an allergy to certain woods. Also, be aware that small pores in the wood can harbor bacteria and other germs. Use these plugs at your own risk. They come pre-oiled; this helps to fill in the pores, protect against rapid changes in moisture levels, and makes for smoother insertion. The oil will release slowly and may aid in softening tissue and helping the body to absorb unwanted hard, connective tissue.

Jojoba oil is recommended to keep your plugs looking their best; other suggested oils include: olive, peanut (though both may break down with heat), mineral, or Vitamin E. They should be washed periodically with a mild non-chemical soap; please see our care instructions for more information.

We use: **ebony, chakte kok, chechen, granadillo, katalox, and olivewood.** Please refer to old price lists or the website for descriptions & color scans.

We accept custom wood orders with deposits. Please specify:

- **overall shape:** saddle (double flares), cylinder (no flares), one flared, or taper; custom labret and tongue shapes are available for \$5 extra;
- **length:** the average is 1/2" overall for saddles, 9/16"-5/8" for cylinders; be sure to allow extra room if tissue is thick or o-rings are to be worn.

We also have a limited amount of pre-made pairs already in stock (some with fancy inlays such as ammonites), as well as giant wooden spirals or cross-over coils. We no longer offer custom engraving or inlay work.

## ♦ S T O N E ♦

- Jade, obsidian, quartz, petrified wood, sodalite, lapis, jasper, agate, tiger's eye, turquoise, amazonite, amethyst, aventurine, and other double flared stone plugs range from 6ga to 3" and are \$10-\$200/pair.
- Stone labrets and septum pieces range from 6ga to 7/8" and are \$20-\$65/ea.
- Stone beads and shapes appropriate for body piercing jewelry are available for \$1-\$10/pair, including saddles, cylinders, rods, talons, and crescents.
- Stone earweights in jade, quartz, and serpentine range from \$25-\$125/pair.

## ♦ SILVER & BRONZE & GOLD ♦

- Silver Mexican filigree plugs and hoops, large hollow star cut-out plugs, real leaf earrings, cloud weights, ear spirals, spiral hairsticks, anklets, bracelets, poppy mandala belt buckles, pendants, and stash earrings.
- Ethnic and tribal silver: thin Thai spiral earrings, Indian earrings and plugs, Tuareg hoop earrings, SouthEast Asian hilltribe jewelry & more.
- Bronze and silver: heavy fox, Protong, and light c-shaped earweights.
- Gold: pre-Columbian gold septums, and South Indian gold internally threaded upper ear barbells, nostril jewelry, earrings, and plugs.

## ♦ E T H N I C J E W E L R Y ♦

Thai hilltribe and related ethnic and tribal jewelry, both new and old pieces, are often available, including Karen and Hmong designs in silver, as well as a few designs from Indonesia, Malaysia, Vietnam, Cambodia, Laos, and South China. These range in price from around \$20-\$150/pair, based on age, size, condition, and weight. Our current selection is shown online.

South Indian gold earrings and barbells, Aztec, African, and Inuit labrets, New Guinea septum jewelry, Yemeni, Kuchi, Afghani, East Indian, Nepali and Tibetan earrings, rare Naga (N.E. India/W. Burma) glass or quartz weights, Kachin (Burmese) amber plugs, Maasai beaded or copper earrings & other jewelry, Fulani/Peul (Mali) earrings, Mursi (Ethiopia) women's lip plates, & silver Tuareg (North African nomad) earrings are all often available. Feel free to send requests!

Dayak/Orang Ulu ear weights from Borneo in brass/bronze are available sporadically and range from \$40 (typical new pairs) to \$500 (old/rare pairs). We travel there and you may request that we pick up specific designs for you. These include: dragons/nagas, aso's/curli-cues, pears/drops/tops, coils, sets of weights, C-shaped weights, monkeyboys, roosters, and birdies/elephants.

Use Dwolla for online payments. We do not accept credit cards.

International customers: please use International Money Orders, a wire transfer, or well-hidden cash in U. S. dollars. Cash is always accepted.

### DOMESTIC SHIPPING FEES (FOR MOST SMALL SHIPMENTS):

\$4 for 1<sup>st</sup> class mail (= 1 week) • \$7 for Priority Mail (2-3 days)

Insurance is: \$3 for up to \$100 worth; \$4 up to \$200; \$5 up to \$300

- Express Mail is \$24 most shipments; \$25-38 up to 1lb.; \$27-42 up to 2lbs.
- Add ≥\$2/pound for heavy shipments (ex: o-ring kits or t-shirts)

COD (Collect on Delivery) shipments have extra fees:

It costs \$8 for up to \$50 to be collected; \$9 for \$100; \$11 for \$200, etc.

### INTERNATIONAL SHIPPING FEES (FOR MOST SMALL SHIPMENTS):

- 1<sup>st</sup> class mail: \$10 Canada, \$12 Mexico, or \$14 Worldwide
- Priority Mail International small flat-rate envelope or box is: \$24 Canada or \$30-34 Worldwide • Priority Mail International box rate up to one pound is: \$35 Canada, \$39 Mexico, or \$41-\$49 Worldwide.
- Please ask for a quote on larger or heavier packages, for insurance, registration (starts at \$15 plus postage), or Express Mail (\$41-\$64).

- Prepayments by check/M.O. or COD's are used for all new U.S. customers.
- International COD's are not possible-sorry! Prepayments only (M.O./cash).
- All COD shipments automatically include insurance; otherwise, please specify if you want insurance. Orders sent by uninsured mail are at your risk.
- You may schedule a pickup with your own UPS, FedEx, or DHL account.

We reuse and recycle many packaging materials (including baggies, boxes, envelopes, etc.). We encourage and support companies and individuals in following suit; we feel the status of using new packaging materials is far less important than reusing existing ones that are still very functional.

- Use of Organic LLC jewelry (natural & other materials) is at your own risk.
- All jewelry is shipped non-sterile; many pieces cannot be sterilized.
- Please specify ALL dimensions (gauges, inches, or mm's are all fine).
- For current availability on all items, please call, see the website for color images, or send a SASE for black and white catalog pages.
- All sales are final. No refunds. All prices are subject to change w/o notice.
- All goods are sold on an "as is" basis without warranties of any kind. Organic LLC expressly denies & disclaims any implied warranty that goods shall be fit for any particular purpose.
- Claims, defects, or damages must be made by the customer in writing within a period of fifteen days of delivery or will not be accepted. All packaging materials must be saved for inspection. As most natural jewelry cannot be sterilized, jewelry returns cannot be accepted, unless there has been a mistake on our behalf (i.e. a sizing error), AND the jewelry has not been used, worn, tried on, damaged, dropped, or mishandled. Returns of unused merchandise may be exchanged for credit only with prior approval.
- NSF (bounced) checks, and returned/refused COD's, will be billed a \$25 service charge. We may redeposit NSF checks electronically; the \$25 fee may also be debited from your account at that time.

Billing is net-15. Late payments will be charged a late fee (which also applies to NSF checks) of 10% of the amount due, or \$20: whichever is higher; interest will accrue at .75%/month.

Please note that we specialize in unique, small-run, handmade jewelry: we do not do mass production. Color, size, appearance, and other factors may vary.
