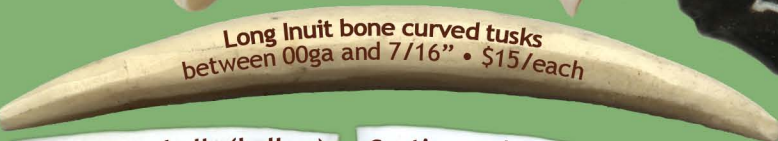

Water buffalo horn shapes include: Marquesas Islands hollow pattern, septum pinchers (also in bone), bamboo root segmented hoops, Borneo flares, teardrop and wicked spirals, Berber dots, & super tiny spirals.

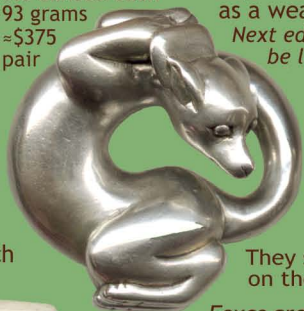


Fox earweights!

Silver foxes
3.3 ounces/each
93 grams
≈\$375 pair

Either the tail section or the body itself can be used as a wearing surface
Next edition may be larger

Bronze foxies
2.65 ounces/each
75 grams
≈\$195 pair



They stand up on their own!

Foxes are very heavy and must be used with extreme caution
